



## **WSO Secondary Homelearning Policy**

- Homelearning will be designed to help to facilitate students becoming High Performance Learners •
- Homelearning should allow students to practice the skills they have learnt within lessons .
- The amount of homelearning should be well-balanced, ensuring it enables students to continue their • enjoyment of learning at home, whilst also giving them some much-needed downtime
- Students must be given a sufficient amount of time to complete the homelearning. At least a week should be ٠ given for Year 7, 8 and 9 homework
- All homelearning completed by students, whether optional or compulsory, must be acknowledged by • teachers and feedback given. This feedback may be done via peer or self assessment
- Optional homelearning must not cover content needed to access future lessons •

Year 9	<ul> <li>Compulsory homelearning for Maths, English and Science – 30minutes each, per week</li> <li>All other subjects must set optional homelearning         <ul> <li>Optional homelearning could be set as an open-ended question for students to explore through a unit or half term</li> <li>If setting optional homework each week: 30 minutes per week should be the limit</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
Year 10	30minutes compulsory homelearning per week, per subject
Year 11	30minutes compulsory homelearning per week, per subject
Year 12	A minimum of one hour compulsory home learning per week, per subject, as directed by the classroom teacher. Different pathways' home learning needs will vary throughout the academic year.
Year 13	A minimum of one hour compulsory home learning per week, per subject, as directed by the classroom teacher. Different pathway's home learning needs will vary throughout the academic year.
